

Water Conservation Programs and Measures

The Mojave Region CII Turf Removal Program is not locally cost-effective. The present value of the costs of implementing the program is \$570 per acre-foot (af) (see Attachment 3, page 3-11). The value of the saved water, assuming that the water saved is split equally between SWP and groundwater and including pumping and transmission costs supplies, is \$262 per af. This is based on an average delivered rate for SWP supplies of \$425 per af and \$100 per af for groundwater.¹
