The State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division), received your Initial Statement of Water Diversion and Use (Statement) filed on **6/27/2013** for the diversion site named **Big Creek Diversion to Eagle Ditch**. This letter is confirmation that the Division has reviewed and processed the Statement related to your claim. Your Statement has been assigned identification number **S023966**. This number should be referenced in all correspondence with the Division regarding the Statement.

You will now be required to file an on-line Supplemental Statement of Water Diversion and Use Report (Supplemental Statement) for **S023966** every three years. The Division will notify you when you are due to file. Additionally, you are also required to file a Supplemental Statement if there is a change in the name or address of the person diverting water. (Water Code, § 5104, subd. (b).). You may also notify the Division of any change in diverter, responsible party or mailing address by visiting our website at: [http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/waterrights/publications\\_forms/forms/](http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/waterrights/publications_forms/forms/). Due to recent changes in reporting requirements paper filing of Supplemental Statements will no longer be accepted.

Your water diversion might be subject to the notification requirements in Fish and Game Code §1602. Information regarding the Department of Fish and Wildlife's (DFW) Lake and Streambed Alteration program and DFW's Regional Office directory can be found on DFW's website at: <http://www.dfg.ca.gov/habcon/1600/>.

The submittal of a Supplemental Statement is a record of your water use. It is used by the Division to verify existing data and to notify you of water right matters related to your claim.

Please be advised that if you have a riparian right, your right does not generally permit you to store water. Stock ponds or reservoirs filled with water diverted pursuant to a riparian right may be subject to enforcement action.

# Information and Instructions for Completing the Initial Statement Form

## GENERAL INFORMATION

California law requires each person or entity that uses diverted surface water, underflow from a surface stream, or groundwater from a known and definite subterranean stream to: (1) file a Statement of Water Diversion and Use (Statement); or (2) file an application to appropriate water with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division). A Statement should be filed if water is diverted and used under a claim of riparian entitlement to the natural stream flow. A valid riparian claim is a vested right that is usually superior to any permit or license issued by the Division to appropriate water. Therefore, it is advantageous to document the riparian claim by filing a Statement for diversions made under such right. A Statement should also be filed for "pre-1914" water rights for water diversions that occurred prior to the establishment of the State Water Commission (the predecessor to the State Water Board) on December 19, 1914. With few exceptions, Statements should be filed for any diversion that occurred after January 1, 2009 and is not covered by a permit or license.

The filing of a statement (1) provides a record of water use, (2) enables the State to notify such users if someone proposes a new appropriation upstream from their diversion, and (3) assists the State in determining if additional water is available for future appropriators.

**Failure to file a statement for each diversion that occurred after January 1, 2009, may result in civil liabilities that carry a maximum fine of \$1,000 plus \$500 for each day the violation continues if the violation is not corrected within 30 days of notification of the violation. Water diverters must file statements of diversion with the State Water Board prior to July 1 of the year succeeding the year of the diversion.**

## PRIOR TO FILLING OUT FORM

Use this guide to determine if you need to file an Initial Statement of Water Diversion and Use. This information can also be found in the California Water Code sections 5100-5107. You do NOT need to file a statement if any of the following conditions are true:

- the diversion is from a spring that does not flow off the property on which it is located and from which the person's aggregate diversions do not exceed 25 acre-feet in any year;
- the diversion is covered by a permit or license to appropriate water that is on file with the Division;
- the diversion is covered by a registration for small domestic, small irrigation, or livestock stockpond uses,
- or covered by a State Water Board stockpond certificate issued for ponds with a storage capacity of 10 or less acre-feet in either program;
- a notice is filed with the State Water Board for the recordation of groundwater extractions and diversions in Los Angeles, Riverside, San Bernardino, and Ventura Counties;

- a diversion is regulated by a watermaster appointed by the Department of Water Resources and included in annual reports filed with a court or the State Water Board by the watermaster, which reports identify the persons who diverted water and describe the general purposes and the place, the use, and the quantity of water that has been diverted from each source;
- a diversion is included in annual reports filed with a court or with the State Water Board by a watermaster appointed by a court or filed pursuant to statute to administer a final judgment determining rights to water, for which reports identify the persons who have diverted water and give the general place of use and the quantity that has been diverted from each source.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Required sections are indicated with an asterisk (\*). All required fields must be completed or the form will not be accepted.

**A separate statement should be filed for each individual diversion point from which water is diverted as outlined in California Water Code section 5102.**

**The following describes the information requested on the form:**

### A. Claimant Information\*

The claimant is the party responsible for the diversion. As the claimant you are required to provide your name or company name and a mailing address. The information provided on your form will be made available on our website. You may substitute your personal information with a PO Box or a business address, phone number and email address, if available. If you would like to designate an agent to act on your behalf to receive all notices related to your Statement, provide the name and address of your designated agent. The phone number and email address should be provided, if available.

If you are not the owner of the land in which the diversion occurs, provide the name and contact information of the landowner.

### B. Certification of Statement\*

All fields must be complete and the form must be legible and signed by the person completing the form. The company name is required if applicable.

#### 1. Type of Claim

Indicate the type of claim you are filing. See the claim descriptions below if you are unsure of the type of claim you are using. You may check more than one box on the form if your diversion is covered by more than one claim. The following are descriptions of the type of water rights that a user may claim use under:

**Riparian:** A riparian right enables an owner of land bordering a natural lake or stream to take and use water on his riparian land. Riparian land must be in the same watershed as the water source and must never have been severed from the source of supply by an intervening parcel without reservation of the

riparian right to the severed parcel. Generally, a riparian water user must share the water supply with other riparian users. A riparian water right, like all water rights in California, is subject to Article X section 2 of the California Constitution which prohibits waste and unreasonable use of water, including the unreasonable method of use or diversion of water. Riparian rights may be used to divert the natural flow of a stream but typically may not be used to (1) store water for later use (2) divert water which originates in a different watershed (3) divert water released from storage, or (4) divert return flows from groundwater use.

You are not required to file a statement of water diversion and use if you have not or currently are not diverting water. If you begin diverting water in the future, you will then be required to submit an initial statement. The filing of a statement is not required to preserve a riparian right.

**Pre-1914 Appropriative:** A pre-1914 appropriative right is for diversions that have been under continuous use since December 19, 1914. After the formation of the California Water Commission in December 1914, new appropriators are required to obtain a permit or license from the State.

**Court Decree:** An adjudicated right is one in which a court or the State Water Board has determined, by decree, the amount of use allowed to landowners within the adjudicated stream area. You must file a statement if you are in an adjudicated area if a watermaster is not filing reports on your behalf. Indicate the decree number when filing a statement on a court decree claim.

**Pending Appropriative:** An appropriative right is required for use of water on non-riparian land and for storage of water. Generally, appropriative rights may be exercised only when there is a surplus not needed by riparian water users. If you have filed an application for a water right permit and are not yet permitted, but water is being diverted, you are required to file a statement. Indicate the corresponding application ID number on this line.

#### 2. Water Course Description\*

Indicate the name of the body of water from which you are diverting water and body of water it is a tributary to.

#### 3. Legal Land Description\*

Provide the location of the point of diversion and indicate which coordinate method you are using or plot the point of diversion on an attached map. Each separate diversion point should be reported on separate Initial Statement forms.

**ABOUT MAPS:** You may submit a single map showing both the point of diversion and the place of use (Items D\* and E\*). Maps can be found at: <http://store.usgs.gov/>

### 3. Legal Land Description (continued)\*

List the County where the diversion occurs and, if available, the Assessor's Parcel Number. Provide the public land description, if assigned, for the quarter-quarter, section, township, range and meridian in which the diversion occurs.

### 4. Place of Use Description\*

Outline the area where the water is used. ABOUT MAPS: You MUST submit a USGS topographic map outlining the place of use. Failure to submit an appropriate map will result in your statement filing being returned to you for corrections. If you are also using a USGS topographic map for the point of diversion, you can draw both on a single map (items \*D and \*E). Maps can be found at: <http://store.usgs.gov/>

### 5. Purpose of Use Description

Indicate the purpose of use for the diverted water. ### 6. Diversion Works Description

The maximum capacity of the diversion works is the maximum output available for a pump or other diversion source. If you store water and know the storage capacity indicate in gallons or acre-feet. If you do not know the actual storage capacity, you can use the following formula to estimate: Multiply the surface area (in acres) by the maximum depth of the reservoir (in feet) then multiply that number by 7.

### 7. Quantity of Water Diverted\*

Provide the quantity of water used for each month in the year you are reporting. If you did not divert water in a particular month, enter "0". Beginning January 1, 2012, monthly measurement records of water diversions must be made using the best available technologies and best professional practices.

### 8. Measurement Device Description\*

Beginning January 1, 2012, water diverters who are required to file a Statement of Water Diversion and Use are required to measure their water diversions using best available technology and best professional practices. If diversions are not measured using best available technology, the diverter must describe why such measurement is not locally cost-effective. ### 10. Recent Water Use

Provide the annual amount of water used in recent years. If precise measurements are not available, provide an estimated annual usage.

### 11. Water Conservation Efforts

Complete item K if you are filing under pre-1914 appropriative water rights and are using conservation methods, using recycled or treated water, or using groundwater in lieu of surface water.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Q: Why do I need to submit a Statement of my diversion?

A: A statement record allows the Division to notify water users about applications to appropriate water that might affect a user's available water supplies. The information collected from the Statements helps the Division to protect the rights of existing and known diverters and to evaluate whether there is a reasonable likelihood that water is available for new applications. Water use reported on Statements also helps the Division to assure the proper allocation of the state's water resources.

#### Q: When should I file my statement?

A: An initial statement should be filed for a diversion that takes place in the prior year. For example, if water was diverted any time in annual year 2011, a statement must be filed on or after January 1, 2012 but no later than June 30, 2012. A separate initial statement should be completed for each point of diversion.

#### Q: What happens after I submit my statement?

A: Once a Statement is received at the Division, it is reviewed for acceptability in accordance with the conditions listed above. The Division will assign a Statement Number to accepted Statements. If a Statement is inadequate, the Division will notify the diverter of the deficiencies. All correspondence concerning these Statements should refer to the assigned Statement number or Statement deficiency number.

#### Q: How often do I need to report usage in subsequent years?

A: Supplemental Statements must be filed by the owner or agent of record at three-year intervals and must be filed with the Division prior to July 1 of the reporting year.

#### Q: How can I update or make changes to my information?

A: Changes in the name and address of the person diverting the water should be made on the Supplemental Statement, or may be made by using a Notice of Assignment form. Ownership information must be reported promptly at the time of transfer, regardless of whether it occurred during a reporting year. If the location of the existing point of diversion as identified on the Initial or Supplemental Statement has changed, the new location must be identified. If there is a new point of diversion, a separate Statement must be filed with the Division.

#### Q: What happens if I move and do not notify the Division of an address or ownership change?

A: If a Supplemental Statement is returned to the Division from the U.S. Postal Service, the diverter's water use will be considered inactive and the Division's database will be modified to reflect this status. This database modification will prompt the Division to stop mailing Supplemental Statements and notices of proposed appropriations. The Division must be notified if a diverter wishes to reactivate an inactive Statement in order to record their diversion and use of water.

#### Q: Do I need approval from any other agencies to divert water?

You are responsible for ensuring all proper permits from local, state or federal agencies are acquired. One common approval that is necessary is a stream alteration agreement (SAA) with the Department of Fish and Game. # Information and Instructions for Completing the Initial Statement Form

## GENERAL INFORMATION

California law requires each person or entity that uses diverted surface water, underflow from a surface stream, or groundwater from a known and definite subterranean stream to: (1) file a Statement of Water Diversion and Use (Statement); or (2) file an application to appropriate water with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division). A Statement should be filed if water is diverted and used under a claim of riparian entitlement to the natural stream flow. A valid riparian claim is a vested right that is usually superior to any permit or license issued by the Division to appropriate water. Therefore, it is advantageous to document the riparian claim by filing a Statement for diversions made under such right. A Statement should also be filed for "pre-1914" water rights for water diversions that occurred prior to the establishment of the State Water Commission (the predecessor to the State Water Board) on December 19, 1914. With few exceptions, Statements should be filed for any diversion that occurred after January 1, 2009 and is not covered by a permit or license.

The filing of a statement (1) provides a record of water use, (2) enables the State to notify such users if someone proposes a new appropriation upstream from their diversion, and (3) assists the State in determining if additional water is available for future appropriators.

**Failure to file a statement for each diversion that occurred after January 1, 2009, may result in civil liabilities that carry a maximum fine of \$1,000 plus \$500 for each day the violation continues if the violation is not corrected within 30 days of notification of the violation. Water diverters must file statements of diversion with the State Water Board prior to July 1 of the year succeeding the year of the diversion.**

## PRIOR TO FILLING OUT FORM

Use this guide to determine if you need to file an Initial Statement of Water Diversion and Use. This information can also be found in the California Water Code sections 5100-5107. You do NOT need to file a statement if any of the following conditions are true:

- the diversion is from a spring that does not flow off the property on which it is located and from which the person's aggregate diversions do not exceed 25 acre-feet in any year;
- the diversion is covered by a permit or license to appropriate water that is on file with the Division;
- the diversion is covered by a registration for small domestic, small irrigation, or livestock stockpond uses,
- or covered by a State Water Board stockpond certificate issued for ponds with a storage capacity of 10 or less acre-feet in either program;
- a notice is filed with the State Water Board for the recordation of groundwater extractions and diversions in Los Angeles, Riverside, San Bernardino, and Ventura Counties;

- a diversion is regulated by a watermaster appointed by the Department of Water Resources and included in annual reports filed with a court or the State Water Board by the watermaster, which reports identify the persons who diverted water and describe the general purposes and the place, the use, and the quantity of water that has been diverted from each source;
- a diversion is included in annual reports filed with a court or with the State Water Board by a watermaster appointed by a court or filed pursuant to statute to administer a final judgment determining rights to water, for which reports identify the persons who have diverted water and give the general place of use and the quantity that has been diverted from each source.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Required sections are indicated with an asterisk (\*). All required fields must be completed or the form will not be accepted.

**A separate statement should be filed for each individual diversion point from which water is diverted as outlined in California Water Code section 5102.**

**The following describes the information requested on the form:**

### A. Claimant Information\*

The claimant is the party responsible for the diversion. As the claimant you are required to provide your name or company name and a mailing address. The information provided on your form will be made available on our website. You may substitute your personal information with a PO Box or a business address, phone number and email address, if available. If you would like to designate an agent to act on your behalf to receive all notices related to your Statement, provide the name and address of your designated agent. The phone number and email address should be provided, if available.

If you are not the owner of the land in which the diversion occurs, provide the name and contact information of the landowner.

### B. Certification of Statement\*

All fields must be complete and the form must be legible and signed by the person completing the form. The company name is required if applicable.

### 1. Type of Claim

Indicate the type of claim you are filing. See the claim descriptions below if you are unsure of the type of claim you are using. You may check more than one box on the form if your diversion is covered by more than one claim. The following are descriptions of the type of water rights that a user may claim use under:

**Riparian:** A riparian right enables an owner of land bordering a natural lake or stream to take and use water on his riparian land. Riparian land must be in the same watershed as the water source and must never have been severed from the source of supply by an intervening parcel without reservation of the

riparian right to the severed parcel. Generally, a riparian water user must share the water supply with other riparian users. A riparian water right, like all water rights in California, is subject to Article X section 2 of the California Constitution which prohibits waste and unreasonable use of water, including the unreasonable method of use or diversion of water. Riparian rights may be used to divert the natural flow of a stream but typically may not be used to (1) store water for later use (2) divert water which originates in a different watershed (3) divert water released from storage, or (4) divert return flows from groundwater use.

You are not required to file a statement of water diversion and use if you have not or currently are not diverting water. If you begin diverting water in the future, you will then be required to submit an initial statement. The filing of a statement is not required to preserve a riparian right.

**Pre-1914 Appropriative:** A pre-1914 appropriative right is for diversions that have been under continuous use since December 19, 1914. After the formation of the California Water Commission in December 1914, new appropriators are required to obtain a permit or license from the State.

**Court Decree:** An adjudicated right is one in which a court or the State Water Board has determined, by decree, the amount of use allowed to landowners within the adjudicated stream area. You must file a statement if you are in an adjudicated area if a watermaster is not filing reports on your behalf. Indicate the decree number when filing a statement on a court decree claim.

**Pending Appropriative:** An appropriative right is required for use of water on non-riparian land and for storage of water. Generally, appropriative rights may be exercised only when there is a surplus not needed by riparian water users. If you have filed an application for a water right permit and are not yet permitted, but water is being diverted, you are required to file a statement. Indicate the corresponding application ID number on this line.

### 2. Water Course Description\*

Indicate the name of the body of water from which you are diverting water and body of water it is a tributary to.

### 3. Legal Land Description\*

Provide the location of the point of diversion and indicate which coordinate method you are using or plot the point of diversion on an attached map. Each separate diversion point should be reported on separate Initial Statement forms

**ABOUT MAPS:** You may submit a single map showing both the point of diversion and the place of use (items D\* and E\*). Maps can be found at: <http://store.usgs.gov/>

### 3. Legal Land Description (continued)\*

List the County where the diversion occurs and, if available, the Assessor's Parcel Number. Provide the public land description, if assigned, for the quarter-quarter, section, township, range and meridian in which the diversion occurs.

### 4. Place of Use Description\*

Outline the area where the water is used. ABOUT MAPS: You MUST submit a USGS topographic map outlining the place of use. Failure to submit an appropriate map will result in your statement filing being returned to you for corrections. If you are also using a USGS topographic map for the point of diversion, you can draw both on a single map (items \*D and \*E). Maps can be found at: <http://store.usgs.gov/>

### 5. Purpose of Use Description

Indicate the purpose of use for the diverted water. Examples of purposes of use are: domestic, dust control, fire protection, fish/wildlife protection and enhancement, fish culture, frost protection, heat protection, incidental power, industrial, irrigation, milling, mining, municipal, power, recreational, snow making, stock watering, etc.). Also indicate the number of acres irrigated, number of persons served for domestic consumption, number of head watered, etc.

### 6. Diversion Works Description

The maximum capacity of the diversion works is the maximum output available for a pump or other diversion source. If you store water and know the storage capacity indicate in gallons or acre-feet. If you do not know the actual storage capacity, you can use the following formula to estimate: Multiply the surface area (in acres) by the maximum depth of the reservoir (in feet) then multiply that number by 7.

### 7. Quantity of Water Diverted\*

Provide the quantity of water used for each month in the year you are reporting. If you did not divert water in a particular month, enter "0". Beginning January 1, 2012, monthly measurement records of water diversions must be made using the best available technologies and best professional practices.

### 8. Measurement Device Description\*

Beginning January 1, 2012, water diverters who are required to file a Statement of Water Diversion and Use are required to measure their water diversions using best available technology and best professional practices. If diversions are not measured using best available technology, the diverter must describe why such measurement is not locally cost-effective. Additional information about measurement devices can be found at [http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/waterrights/water\\_issues/programs/diversion\\_use/docs/wm\\_device\\_guide.pdf](http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/waterrights/water_issues/programs/diversion_use/docs/wm_device_guide.pdf).

Indicate the method used to measure the water diverted. This is a new requirement for Statements of Water Diversion and Use. If you measured with a measuring device, complete section 8a and skip section 8b. If you did not use a measuring device, skip section 8a and complete section 8b.

### 8a. Measuring Device

Indicate the types of measuring devices used, any additional technology used and indicate who installed your measuring device. If none of the check box options apply, use the boxes marked other and include an explanation.

### 8b. No Measuring Device Explanation

If you did not measure your diversion with a measuring device using best available technology, you must indicate why installing a measuring device that utilizes best available technology would not be locally cost effective. Also indicate the method used as an alternative to direct measurement methods.

### 9. Monthly Maximum Rate of Diversion

Provide a monthly maximum rate of diversion in the table provided. If precise measurements are not available, provide an estimated average per month.

### 10. Recent Water Use

Provide the annual amount of water used in recent years. If precise measurements are not available, provide an estimated annual usage.

### 11. Water Conservation Efforts

Complete item K if you are filing under pre-1914 appropriative water rights and are using conservation methods, using recycled or treated water, or using groundwater in lieu of surface water.

Faxes and emails must be legible and contain readable maps.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Q: Why do I need to submit a Statement of my diversion?

A: A statement record allows the Division to notify water users about applications to appropriate water that might affect a user's available water supplies. The information collected from the Statements helps the Division to protect the rights of existing and known diverters and to evaluate whether there is a reasonable likelihood that water is available for new applications. Water use reported on Statements also helps the Division to assure the proper allocation of the state's water resources.

#### Q: When should I file my statement?

A: An initial statement should be filed for a diversion that takes place in the prior year. For example, if water was diverted any time in annual year 2011, a statement must be filed on or after January 1, 2012 but no later than June 30, 2012. A separate initial statement should be completed for each point of diversion.

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#### Q: How often do I need to report usage in subsequent years?

A: Supplemental Statements must be filed by the owner or agent of record at three-year intervals and must be filed with the Division prior to July 1 of the reporting year.

#### Q: How can I update or make changes to my information?

A: Changes in the name and address of the person diverting the water should be made on the Supplemental Statement, or may be made by using a Notice of Assignment form. Ownership information must be reported promptly at the time of transfer, regardless of whether it occurred during a reporting year. If the location of the existing point of diversion as identified on the Initial or Supplemental Statement has changed, the new location must be identified. If there is a new point of diversion, a separate Statement must be filed with the Division.

#### Q: What happens if I move and do not notify the Division of an address or ownership change?

A: If a Supplemental Statement is returned to the Division from the U.S. Postal Service, the diverter's water use will be considered inactive and the Division's database will be modified to reflect this status. This database modification will prompt the Division to stop mailing Supplemental Statements and notices of proposed appropriations. The Division must be notified if a diverter wishes to reactivate an inactive Statement in order to record their diversion and use of water.
