The projects in the Upper Pit River Watershed Water Conservation and Drought Mitigation application are deemed “exempt” from submitting AWMP to the Department of Water Resources since none of them meet the required “25,000 acres of irrigated land” in the project areas as well as the District’s areas.

Each project sponsor does belong to the Northeastern California Water Association (NECWA) Irrigated Lands program. NECWA is planning a training calendar to assist each landowner in the region to develop individual AWMP in the future.
