Ten of the eleven participating agencies have been deemed complete in the table. These agencies are listed below along with the date of review completion provided by DWR. The only agency not in the table is the City of Lincoln. Lincoln submitted its UWMP on September 30, 2011. Upon inquiry to DWR from RWA about the status of the Lincoln UWMP, DWR confirmed that the UWMP has been deemed complete and provided a confirmation letter dated July 9, 2014. Completed AB 1420 self-certification forms have been completed for all participating 11 urban water suppliers. **Signed originals of the AB 1420 self-certification forms are included with the hard copy submittal component of this application.**

Water metering self-certification forms for 10 of the 11 participating urban water suppliers have been completed. Sacramento County Water Agency (SCWA) did not sign the certification form, because it has meters that are still in the process of being installed that are subject to a Central Valley Project (CVP) water contract. Per the CVP, the meters should have been installed by January 1, 2013. However, due to the extreme economic downturn, SCWA had to reprioritize its budget prior to the deadline. SCWA has coordinated with Reclamation on the issue, and the remaining meters are in the process of being installed. The remaining meters will be installed by December 31, 2014. SCWA's water metering self-certification signed form will be provided to DWR upon completion of the meter installation. **Signed originals of the water metering compliance self-certification forms are included with the hard copy submittal component of this application.**

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has reviewed the City of Lincoln's (City) 2010 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) received on August 11, 2011. The California Water Code (CWC) directs DWR to report to the legislature once every five years on the status of submitted plans. In meeting this legislative reporting requirement, DWR reviews all submitted plans.

DWR's review of the City's 2010 plan has found that the plan has addressed the requirements of the CWC. DWR's review of plans is limited to assessing whether suppliers have addressed the required legislative elements. In its review, DWR does not evaluate or analyze the supplier's UWMP data, projections, or water management strategies. This letter is meant to acknowledge that the City's 2010 UWMP has addressed these requirements. The results of the review will also be provided to DWR's Financial Assistance Branch.
