


## **Interregional Landscape Water Demand Reduction Program**

3. Upper Santa Ana Valley; Basin Number 8-2.02; Medium Priority (Cucamonga)
  - Monitoring entity is Chino Basin Water Master
4. Upper Santa Ana Valley; Basin Number 8-2.03; High Priority (Riverside-Arlington)
  - Monitoring entity is Western Municipal Water District
5. Upper Santa Ana Valley; Basin Number 8-2.04; Medium Priority (Rialto-Colton)
  - Monitoring entity is San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District
6. Upper Santa Ana Valley; Basin Number 8-2.05; Very Low Priority (Cajon)
7. Upper Santa Ana Valley; Basin Number 8-2.06; High Priority (Bunker Hill)

13. Hemet Lake Valley; Basin Number: 8-6; Very Low Priority
14. Big Meadows Valley; Basin Number: 8-7; Very Low Priority
15. Seven Oaks Valley; Basin Number: 8-8; Very Low Priority
16. Bear Valley; Basin Number: 8-9; Medium Priority.
  - There is no monitoring entity. Big Bear City Community Services District is working towards becoming the CASGEM monitoring entity and working through issues with the Big Bear Lake Department of Water and Power.

In the USMW IRWM Region, RCWD is the CASGEM monitoring entity for the Temecula Valley Basin (Murrieta-Temecula Basin), listed as a high priority basin, and is in compliance with DWR's CASGEM Program.
