The focus of the proposed program is on water use efficiency approaches, such as turf removal, and technology-based information systems and conservation-based water rates that will encourage conservation. This allows the region to target significant water conservation in parallel with creating transformation of customers' view of the nexus between water's value and its reasonable use. Water use efficiency projects with the specific components proposed are focused on the demand side of the water resources equation, while groundwater projects, like those that include recharge or banking, are focused on the supply side.
