

4.2 Eligible Applicant Documentation

Eligible applicants are local agencies or non-profit organizations. If DWR determines that the applicant does not have the authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State, the applicant will not be eligible for funding and application will not be reviewed. If the applicant has applied for an IRWM Grant after January 1, 2012, state as such and the applicant is not required to submit the following eligible applicant information. If not, the applicant must provide a written statement (and additional information if noted) containing the appropriate information outlined below:

- *Is the applicant a local agency as defined in Appendix B of the 2015 IRWM Guidelines? Please explain.*
- *What is the statutory or other legal authority under which the applicant was formed and is authorized to operate?*
- *Does the applicant have legal authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State of California?*
- *Describe any legal agreements among partner agencies and/or organizations that ensure performance of the Proposal and tracking of funds.*

Kaweah Delta Water Conservation District (KDWCD) is a local agency as defined in Appendix B of the 2015 IRWM Drought Guidelines; specifically it is a special district. KDWCD has served as the applicant for multiple Kaweah River Basin IRWM Grant efforts, the most recent being the 2014 Drought Solicitation. With the latest application coming after January 1, 2012, the remaining eligibility documentation has not been included, per PSP guidelines.
