

Authorization and Eligibility Requirements

CASGEM Compliance

As defined in the IRWM Grant Program Guidelines, CWC §10933.7 states that if the grant applicant or project proponents’ jurisdictions include unmonitored high and medium priority groundwater basins, and they match the list of potential monitoring entities identified in CWC §10927, they will not be eligible to receive Prop 84, 2015 IRWM Grant funding. Table 1-9 lists each medium and high priority groundwater basins, monitoring entities and designation status, overlying applicant or proponent agency name, and overlying projects with latitude and longitude. Note that the following projects do not overlie groundwater basins: Las Virgenes Creek Restoration Project – Phase II, Urban Streams Restoration in the Malibu Creek Watershed, and Recycled Water Supply for Palos Verdes Golf Course.

All medium and high priority basins have been assigned a monitoring entity. A map showing groundwater basin priorities, monitoring entities, applicant and proponent boundaries, and project locations is shown in Figures 1-1. The shapefiles of each agency’s boundary and project locations are included as uploads to the GRanTS website.
