**Attachment 1 – Eligibility: Agricultural Water Management Compliance**

The projects in the Upper Pit River Disadvantaged Communities' Human Right to Water and Drought Sustainability Projects application are deemed “exempt” from submitting AWMP to the Department of Water Resources since none of them meet the required “25,000 acres of irrigated land” within the project areas, as well as the purveyors' service areas (as applicable).

Each project sponsor does belong to the Northeastern California Water Association (NECWA) Irrigated Lands program. NECWA is assisting regional landowners to develop individual Agricultural Water Management Plans.
