Attachment 1 – Authorization and Eligibility Requirements (5 of 9)

This attachment is divided into separate parts per instructions in the 2015 IRWM Proposal Solicitation Package (PSP). For these parceled attachments all referenced figures and supporting documentation are provided at the end of the document. Supporting documentation is not isolated, such as in numbered appendices, but is rather simply included in the attachment with the implication of a direct connection to the attachment part.

1.5. URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT COMPLIANCE

This proposal contains a DAC project sponsor, LHUD. LHUD represents a community that serves fewer than 3,000 connections and less than 3,000 acre-feet per year (AFY). The DAC community benefits directly from the project in this application, however, it is *not* large enough to meet the definition of “Urban Water Supplier”. Therefore, self-certification for CWC (§525 et seq.) and AB 1420 (CWC §10631.5) is not required. The status of AB 1420 and water meter self-certification documents for this community is presented the following table. In addition, LHUD submitted this urban water management compliance documentation with the 2014 IRWM Drought Grant Solicitation.

¹ Lost Hills Utility District services 299 residential, 3 multi-family and 85 commercial connections, and yearly production is approximately 125 MG or 383.6 AF according to the LHUD Consultant Engineer.
