

## Authorization and Eligibility Requirements

**Adopted IRWM Plan and Proof of Formal Adoption**

The 2014 Upper Santa Margarita Watershed (USMW) IRWM Plan Update, prepared consistent with the 2012 IRWM Program Guideline Plan Standards, was formally adopted in May 2014 by each Regional Water Management Group member – Rancho California Water District (RCWD), Riverside County, and Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District. The IRWM Plan Update was approved by DWR in September 2014. Therefore, based on direction included in the Proposal Solicitation Package for this grant application, no proof of adoption is required to be submitted with this application for these agencies.

In addition, each project proponent included in this proposal has formally adopted the 2014 USMW IRWM Plan Update. RCWD, Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD), and Western Municipal Water District (WMWD) each submitted their proof of formal adoption with the 2014 IRWM Drought Grant Solicitation, in partnership with and led by the Santa Ana River IRWM Watershed. The City of Temecula and Riverside County Parks each formally adopted the 2014 USMW IRWM Plan Update on July 16, 2015 and July 21, 2015, respectively (see Appendix B).
