

## **Pajaro River Watershed Long Term Drought Preparedness**

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### **ATTACHMENT 1: AUTHORIZATION AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

Attachment 1 is mandatory and consists of authorization and eligibility documentation plus demonstration of project consistency with an adopted IRWM Plan, Urban Water Management Compliance, Agricultural Water Management Compliance, Surface Water Diverter Compliance, Groundwater Management Compliance, and CASGEM compliance.

#### **1.1 AUTHORIZING DOCUMENTATION**

The San Benito County Water District (SBCWD) adopted Resolution 2015-17 on July 29, 2015 (Exhibit 1.1) designating the District Manager of SBCWD as the authorized representative to submit the application and execute an agreement with the State of California for an Integrated Regional Water Management Implementation Grant.

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Water Resources is soliciting proposals for funding from the Proposition 84 Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) 2015 Grant Program;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Water Resources requires that each IRWM region submit only one application that includes all high priority water resource projects in the region;

**WHEREAS**, the Pajaro River Watershed IRWM Regional Water Management Group (RWMG) authorized the San Benito County Water District (District) to act as the applicant and the grant manager for the Pajaro River Watershed Proposition 84 IRWM 2015 Grant;

**WHEREAS**, the District is seeking funding for the Design and Construction of the Cross Town Pipeline as a solution to the City of Hollister's Hexavalent Chromium problem; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Watsonville is seeking funding for the design of the Hexavalent Chromium Treatment Project.


**BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

The Board of Directors of the San Benito County Water District hereby authorizes an application be made to the California Department of Water Resources for a 2015 Integrated Regional Water Management Grant pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Public Resource Code Section 75001 et seq.).




