The Oceano CSD and Templeton CSD projects included in this Proposal have potential to directly affect groundwater levels or quality. Therefore hard copies of the required self-certification documentation with wet signatures in compliance with CWC §10753 have been sent to DWR and copies of each of the Project Proponent's compliance certification forms are included in Appendix 1J.

No District projects are included in this proposal. However, it is included here because the District is the lead agency and designated Applicant.

San Simeon CSD overlies the Pico Creek Valley groundwater basin, which is not formally defined under California's Groundwater Bulletin 118 program. As defined in CWC §10752(b), a "groundwater basin" means any basin or subbasin identified in the department's Bulletin No. 118, dated September 1975, and any amendments to that bulletin.

The Pico Creek Valley groundwater basin is 62.5 acres in size and underlies Pico Creek Valley. The basin yield is estimated to be 120 AFY. While San Simeon CSD is a groundwater user, the project does not directly affect groundwater levels or quality as defined by the State and thus groundwater management compliance is not applicable.
