Copies of verifying documentation for required AWMPs by DPWD and SLWD were submitted to DWR as part of the 2014 IRWM Drought Grant Application; therefore, the agencies are not required to submit the documentation for the AWMP compliance requirements as part of this grant application. However, the copies of the documentation required for AWMPs that were submitted as part of the 2014 IRWM Drought Grant Application are included in Appendix 1.6 for reference.

SLWD submitted its AWMP to DWR on June 13, 2014, and its plan was verified to address the requirements of the Water Code in a response letter dated July 10, 2014. DPWD AWMP, dated July 5, 2011, was submitted to DWR and has been verified to address the requirements of the Water Code. CCID's AWMP was submitted to the Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) as part of San Joaquin River Exchange Contractor's Water Management Plan; this plan was approved on May 13, 2015 and verifying documentation is also included in Appendix 1.6. Now that this review has been completed, the AWMP will be submitted to DWR by Reclamation for their review; review of this document by DWR is still pending. The City of Newman, included in this application, is not an agricultural water purveyor and thus is not required to submit AWMP.
