The Lake Camanche Service Lateral Replacement – Phase 3 Project has the potential to benefit water levels or quality for the Consumnes Subbasin. AWA has provided a Certification for Groundwater Management Plan Compliance which is provided in Appendix 1.7.

The MAC Region Conservation Program’s focus is on implementation of urban water use efficiency measures, which are directed towards demand management and therefore is not expected to directly impact groundwater level or quality. The Sheep Ranch Drinking Water Compliance Project will improve drinking water quality through the replacement of existing treatment facilities that treat surface water only, and therefore are not expected to impact groundwater level or quality.
