Dear Mr. Aikens:

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has completed its review of your Agricultural Water Management Plan for the purpose of meeting the requirements of Water Code Sections 10608.48 (a)-(d), and 10800 *et seq.*, Part 2.8. We find that your plan generally meets the requirements of the code sections.

We note, however, that additional details required under Section 10608.48(d) need to be addressed. Specifically:

“...an estimate of the water use efficiency improvements that have occurred since the last report, and an estimate of the water use efficiency improvements estimated to occur five to 10 years in the future.”

DWR recommends that when you update this plan in 2015 that these estimates are included as part of the descriptions of the water use efficiency practices. These estimates may be quantitative or qualitative, based on availability of data.

DWR's review of plans is limited to assessing whether suppliers have addressed the required legislative elements. In its review, DWR does not evaluate or analyze the supplier's plan data, projections, or water management strategies. This letter is meant to acknowledge that the supplier has addressed these requirements. The results of the review will also be provided to the DWR's Water Use and Efficiency grants program and the Financial Assistance Branch, and to any other state agency that offers grants and loans.

DWR intends to update its AWMP Guidebook by the end of 2014 in order to further assist water suppliers in preparing their plans.
