The North Coast Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (NCIRWMP) was developed under the oversight of the North Coast Regional Water Management Group (NCRWMP) in 2005. Proposed planning elements in need of funding that will inform and be integrated into the Phase III Plan include the a Climate Change Mitigation, Adaptation and Energy Independence report, Data Management Plan, Planning Synthesis Report, a Flood and Stormwater Management Report , a Land Use and Regional Planning Report, and North Coast Groundwater Monitoring Strategies report.
