 Proposal Objective The 2005 South Orange County IRWM Plan focuses on the South Orange County region's vision of total watershed efficiency. The Plan complied with Prop 50 IRWM Standards and primarily builds upon the projects and plans of the member agencies, with an emphasis on water supply and water reliability. The objective of this IRWM Planning Grant Proposal is to update and complete a South Orange County IRWM Plan in compliance with Proposition 84 Guidelines. To meet this objective, the proposed work plan includes completion of the following components: 1. Climate Change Analysis 2. Salt & Nutrient Management Plan 3. Floodplain Management Plan 4. Groundwater Management and Facility Plan, and 5. Revised South Orange County IRWMP to meet Proposition 84 IRWM Plan Standards. The overall objectives of the Proposed Revised South Orange County IRWM Plan include: addressing water quality impairments, establishing priorities for water resources needs; integrating water resource solutions across traditional disciplinary bounds; and jointly advocating for policies and funding that assist these goals. The proposed Revised IRWM Plan considers long-term regional planning for flood management; urban runoff management; watershed management; water use efficiency; water supply and reliability; recycled water; habitat preservation, conservation, and restoration; water quality protection and improvement; resource stewardship; and related water resource management strategies facing the Region over the next 20 to 50 years. *
