Proposal Objective The 2006 Westside Integrated Water Resources Plan (WIWRP) is a regional blueprint that guides resource management in the context of environmental and socioeconomic factors. The WIWRP identifies alternatives to reduce the imbalance between water demand and supply while improving environmental and socio-economic status through a series of drainage, flood control, groundwater management, land use, water conservation, water quality, water supply, water use efficiency proposals. The overarching goal of the WIWRP is to minimize regional conflict by addressing the most problematic sources of tension affecting our agricultural, municipal, and environmental water use, namely water supply reliability, drainage, and water quality. This proposal identifies key areas where additional State funding can be used to advance the regional planning efforts and to increase the benefits to be realized from the WIWRP update. Specifically, it is proposed that the funding assistance be used in three ways: 1. To help fund tasks related to the WIWRP update process (i.e. outreach to Disadvantaged Communities (DACs), public outreach, and preparation of the update documents.); 2. To fund a grant program for DACs. This program will assist DACs who choose to undertake topic-specific studies that will result in data that can be extrapolated for use throughout the region. Examples include: wastewater disposal issues, drinking water treatment concerns, and others; 3. To fund topic-specific studies that will further inform the WIWRP development and implementation of strategies to meet regional objectives. Potential studies have been identified including: the Groundwater Banking and Water Resources Feasibility Study, the Water Conveyance Improvement Study, and the Surface Storage Feasibility Study. All of these studies complement and advance the WIWRP objectives and meet statewide DWR IRWM priorities as well as achieve CALFED Bay-Delta Program objectives. *

Proposal Description: This proposal identifies projects where additional State funding can be used to further inform the WIWRP development and implementation of strategies to meet regional objectives. The proposal includes funding assistance for updating and improving the current WIWRP, as well as for projects focused on topic-specific planning efforts. DACs within the region will benefit from participation in the WIWRP update process and from having funds designated solely for DAC topic-specific planning efforts. Planning projects included in the proposal fall into 3 categories: 1. The WIWRP Update Project: This project will help fund tasks related to the WIWRP update process (i.e. outreach to DACs, public outreach, and preparation of the update documents.); 2. The Planning Grant Program for DACs Projects: This project will assist DACs who choose to undertake topic-specific studies that will result in data that can be extrapolated for use throughout the region. Examples may include: wastewater disposal issues, drinking water treatment concerns, and others; 3. The Topic-Specific Studies Project: This project will evaluate opportunities in certain unique geographic areas to implement strategies intended to expand the regional water resource potential and help achieve the WIWRP objectives. Here to, the potential to extrapolate from the knowledge gained will benefit the entire region. The proposed studies include: the Groundwater Banking and Water Resources Feasibility Study, the Water Conveyance Improvement Study, and the Surface Storage Feasibility Study. Additionally, two other studies updating regional water conservation efforts and economic effect are included for reference and budget purposes. All of these topic-specific studies will complement and advance the WIWRP objectives, meet statewide DWR IRWM priorities, and help achieve CALFED Bay-Delta Program objectives.
