Q1. PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION

The Upper Mokelumne River Watershed Authority is submitting a proposal on behalf of the Mokelumne/Amador/Calaveras (MAC) Region. The November 2006 MAC IRWMP was developed based on Proposition 50 Guidelines and requires updating in order to be consistent with current IRWM Plan Standards and most accurately reflect the Region and its needs. Since completion of the existing Plan, the MAC Region has made changes to their boundaries, to the governance structure and Regional Water Management Group (RWMG), and made progress in updating some sections included in the Plan. Additionally, the MAC Region became an approved region through the 2009 RAP. Various sections of the RAP application help to better define the Region and will be used in the IRWM Plan Update. There are some standards that have not been addressed since completion of the existing Plan, so these items will need to be analyzed and developed. The proposed scope of work will be completed in four tasks. The tasks are as follows: Task 1 ??? IRWM Plan Update consists of revising the existing 2006 Plan to fully reflect the progress that have been made in the Region, as well as adding new sections (such as Climate Change) that have not yet been evaluated; Task 2 ??? Conflict Assessment and Collaborative Decision Making Plan is to develop an active collaborative effort to identify and address the specific needs and interests of the MAC Region stakeholders relative to proposed storage and conjunctive use projects; Task 3 ??? Public Outreach is to further facilitate the involvement of disadvantaged communities in the IRWM planning effort and ensure stakeholder involvement throughout the process; and Task 4 ??? Funding Administration includes preparing quarterly progress report and final report, preparing claim submittals, and other administrative tasks. The total proposal cost is \$348,000, with a local match of \$97,091 and total grant request of \$250,909. All tasks are anticipated to be completed with 24 months from execution of the Funding Agreement.
