Proposal Objective The water users in the Madera Region have historically relied on groundwater to meet their domestic water demand and a large portion of their agricultural water demand. This continued reliance is straining groundwater supplies. Also, many areas of the valley floor of this Region are prone to flooding, requiring a comprehensive water management approach. This Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP) will document the collective approach of the Region and its stakeholders to water management to deal with water supply, water quality, climate change, and flood management. The main objectives of the IRWMP are water resource management optimization, evaluating and increasing water supplies, water quality protection and improvement, climate change mitigation/adaptation and flood control planning. The main objective of this proposal is to update the current IRWMP from the Proposition 50 standards to the Proposition 84 standards. *
