Technically the Madera regional boundaries include the Columbia Canal Company, which does receive Delta Water as an Exchange Contractor. However the Columbia Canal Company explicitly does not consider itself part of the Madera Region. Neither it nor any other Exchange Contractor has been involved in the development of the Madera region IRWMP or is expected to be involved in its implementation. Therefore the Madera IRWMP cannot be said to reduce dependence on Delta water supplies.

Neither Madera County nor any of its Special Districts (MD 8, MD 19, MD 33 or CSA 14) rely on any water supplied from the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta. Accordingly, Attachment 13 is not included with this application.
