CLWA submitted its 2005 UWMP to DWR on December 6, 2005. The Plan included its four local retail water agencies in the Santa Clarita Valley: CLWA's Santa Clarita Water Division (SCWD), Newhall County Water District (NCWD), Valencia Water Company (VWC), and Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 36 (LACWWD #36). DWR reviewed and approved the Plan in December 2010. CLWA prepared its 2010 UWMP update which also included the four local retail water agencies in the Santa Clarita Valley. The completed plan was submitted to DWR by the wholesaler deadline of July 21, 2011 and uploaded to the online DOST submittal tool. DWR reviewed the Agency and retailer plans and found that the plans addressed the requirement of the California Water Code via a letter date January 24, 2012.
