The Watersheds Coalition of Ventura County (WCVC) IRWMP was adopted in 2006. Since then, WCVC stakeholders have continuously collaborated on an ongoing IRWM program. Currently, the IRWMP is being updated to become compliant with the 2010 IRWM Guidelines, using local funds, in-kind services and a Proposition 84 Round 1 Planning Grant. As part of this regional planning grant proposal two special studies are proposed to enhance the IRWMP update and overall water resource management in the WCVC: (1) Lower Santa Clara River Basins Salt and Nutrient Management Plan (hereafter Regional LSCR Plan); (2) Las Posas Basin Conjunctive Use Study (hereafter Las Posas Study). The work proposed as part of this application will: enhance the Region understanding, facilitate Disadvantaged Community (DAC) outreach and increase stakeholder participation, fill data gaps, improve coordination between regions, inform the discussion on climate change adaption, and serve as a framework for regional implementation of similar efforts. Both of the proposed studies represent critical steps in furthering many IRWMP and watershed-specific objectives: (a) Reduce dependence on imported water and protect, conserve and augment water supplies; (b) Protect and improve water quality; (c) Improve water supply reliability. The Regional LSCR Plan constitutes a solution to managing salt and nutrient issues in four groundwater basins on the lower Santa Clara River: the Mound, Santa Paula, Fillmore, and Piru basins. This effort will be led by the Ventura County Watershed Protection District, in partnership with the Cities of Ventura, Santa Paula, Fillmore and community of Piru (represented by Ventura County Waterworks District No. 16). The Regional LSCR Plan will focus on water quality protection in basins underlying current and future water recycling projects in the lower Santa Clara River, therefore allowing multiple agencies to continue or expand recycled water use in their service areas to augment regional water supplies, improve water quality and supply reliability and reduce dependence on imported water. The primary purpose of the Las Posas Study is to better understand opportunities and constraints to developing the shallow brackish groundwater resources of the East and South Las Posas basins. This study will create the framework for advancing brackish groundwater production, treatment and distribution in the Region, and salt export from the watershed. This represents a crucial step towards using previously untapped groundwater sources to increase regional water supplies and decrease dependence on imported water.

The study will maximize the effectiveness of basin management strategies with a coordinated approach for sharing the costs and benefits of developing the shallow aquifer. Further, the Las Posas Study will enable the development of these new resources to be effectively integrated within the overall groundwater management context and may increase aquifer storage for future conjunctive use projects. There are multiple pockets of DACs in the study areas of the proposed projects. Because these projects will directly address the water quality and supply needs of these communities, this proposal includes outreach to DACs. This is a regional proposal, but the studies will provide a forum to coordinate with neighboring IRWMPs and will have interregional benefits.
