Proposal Name Addressing Critical Gaps in the IRWM Plan for the Greater Monterey County Region *

Proposal Objective
 The RWMG is requesting funds to address critical information gaps in the GMC IRWMP in order to make it a more effective planning document for the region. Because this RWMG is made up of 20 different organizations, without one agency taking a leading role, funding for a Coordinator is integral to the success of the entire effort. This planning grant will provide that much-needed monetary support for the coordination of the IRWM planning process. The requested planning grant funds will also enable the RWMG to strengthen and improve certain elements of IRWM planning; including collecting and assessing data on environmental water needs to ensure future protection, restoration, and improvement of aquatic, riparian, and watershed resources within the region. Two other important regional issues that are included in this planning effort are wildfires and "food safety". They have significant bearing on water management in the Greater Monterey County IRWM region and these tasks present an excellent opportunity to leverage other related regional efforts with the IRWM planning process. In addition, increased funding for DAC technical assistance, interregional planning, and an analysis of the potential barriers to project implementation are included in this proposal to ensure successful implementation of the IRWM Plan. *

The Greater Monterey County RWMG is requesting \$244,730 to address critical information gaps in the IRWM Plan, and to provide much-needed support for the IRWM planning process. Round 1 Planning Grant funds will enable the RWMG to produce a standards compliant Plan by Fall 2012; however, critical gaps will still exist, including a lack of data on environmental water needs and the lack of consideration of two important regional issues, wildfires and food safety, that have significant bearing on water management in the Greater Monterey County IRWM region. While the final approved IRWM Plan will be considered adequate to meet Proposition 84/1E standards, these information gaps may render the Plan less than adequate as an effective planning document for the region. The requested Planning Grant funds will also enable

the RWMG to strengthen and improve certain elements of the IRWM planning process, including increased funding for DAC technical assistance, interregional planning and coordination, and an analysis of the potential barriers to project implementation to help ensure successful implementation of the IRWM Plan.
