*Attachment 2: Eligible Applicant Documentation***

The applicant, Plumas County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, a local agency as defined in Appendix B of the Guidelines, is a special act water district established by the State Legislature and governed by the Plumas County Board of Supervisors. Plumas County is a political subdivision of the State of California. The Plumas County Flood Control and Water Conservation District has the legal authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State of California. Resolution No. 2012-7756 authorizes the Plumas County Flood Control and Water Conservation District to apply for a grant and enter into a grant agreement with the State of California.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) of the Upper Feather River (UFR) Region, included in Appendix C of Attachment 3: Work Plan, authorizes the Plumas County Flood Control and Water Conservation District to act as the program IRWM administrative agency named “Fiscal Agent” in Section 3.03 of the MOU on behalf of the UFR Region. The MOU was authorized by members of the Regional Water Management Group (RWMG) for the UFR Region. The MOU has measures in place for the Fiscal Agent to ensure the performance of the proposal and tracking of grant funds.
