Proposal Objective
 The overarching objective is to continue the significant progress which has been made with regard to integrated regional water management planning and project implementation within the Poso Creek Region since formation of the Poso Creek Regional Water Management Group (RWMG) in 2005. Specifically, this proposal is intended to help fund the planning necessary to update and improve the adopted 2007 IRWM Plan such that it is compliant with present standards; to advance project "readiness" through selected preliminary engineering studies; and to enhance public outreach. The RWMG has been meeting regularly since Plan adoption to meet Plan objectives. As a result of the RWMG's efforts, water resource management projects totaling more than \$35 million have been constructed or are underway in the less than five years since plan adoption. The Poso Creek RWMG has proven that it does not plan for the sake of planning; rather, they plan to implement, and it is intended that this proposal position the RWMG to continue their project implementation efforts. *

Update and Improve Plan: Systematic update of all 16 topic areas discussed in Appendix C of Guidelines will be accomplished; This work plan summarizes activities since 2007 that align with the Standards in the Proposition 84 Guidelines and outlines the additional work to meet the Standards. Advance Project ?Readiness?: To advance project ?readiness?, preliminary engineering studies are included for projects which relate to regional water supply, flood management, and wastewater. There are two wastewater projects, and it is noteworthy that they are both for DACs located within the Region. Improve Public Outreach: It is planned to improve public outreach through development of an enhanced website, with the intent of providing easy and timely public access to meeting notices, agendas, and Plan activity information. Facilitate and Support DAC Participation in the IRWM Planning Process: The proposal will facilitate and support the participation of DACs in the IRWM planning effort. In this regard, the preliminary engineering studies include two DAC projects; one for the City of Delano and one for South Shafter. The DACs in this Region have been actively participating in the planning process since Plan Adoption. A DAC Representative voting position was added with the signing of the Governance MOU in May, 2010. An election of the DAC Representative was completed in December, 2010. DACs and their Stakeholder Group, such as Self-Help Enterprises, are actively participating in planning and implementation activities, this Proposal will advance their involvement.
