



Tahoe-Sierra IRWM Proposition 84 Planning Grant Proposal *Attachment 2: Eligible Applicant Documentation*

The South Tahoe Public Utility District is a publicly-held corporation authorized to operate pursuant to the provisions of Section 9 of the “Public Utility District Act”, as amended, (Act 6391 of Deering’s General Laws) in the State of California. It has the legal authority under this provision to enter into any funding contracts with the State of California.

As lead agency representing the Tahoe Sierra Integrated Regional Water Management partnership, STPUD would hold an Intergovernmental Agreement with each subcontracting agency that is a legally binding document entered into and adopted by the governing entity of each agency. The Intergovernmental Agreement describes the programmatic and fiscal responsibilities of each partner and the consequences of failure to meet them.
