1. Is the applicant a non-profit agency as defined in Appendix B of the Guidelines?  
Please explain.

The applicant is the Yosemite/Sequoia Resource Conservation and Development Council (Council) who will manage the IRWMP update on behalf of the Madera Region Regional Water Management Group (RWMG). The Council is a non-profit agency and was organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes in October 2002.

2. Does the applicant have legal authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State of California?

Yes, the Council has the legal authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State of California.

3. Describe any legal agreements among partner agencies and/or organizations that ensure performance of the Proposal and tracking of funds.

Attached are the Council's Fiscal Agent Qualifications, which describe their experience and numerous qualifications to manage the grant. The qualifications were prepared in 2010 when the RWMG applied for a Planning Grant Application, but the Council considers the document to still be valid. In addition, the Madera Region Regional Water Management Group has a signed contract with their engineering consultant, Provost & Pritchard Consulting Group, to update the IRWMP as described in the Work Plan.
