

No. 37 - Upper Feather River Watershed Integrated Regional Water Management Region

Region Acceptance Process Summary

General Description of Region

The Upper Feather River Watershed Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) Region is an established IRWM Region encompassing all of Plumas County and portions of six other counties in the Sacramento River Hydrologic Region, and it is bounded on the lower end by Lake Oroville. The Upper Feather River Watershed IRWM Plan, adopted by the four original signatories to the IRWM Plan in 2006, will be updated in the future and will seek to increase the amount and diversity of entities adopting the Plan.

Due to the sparsely populated nature of this Region, integration of projects will not occur in a traditional physical sense. Integration in this Region will occur on a more holistic approach, such as re-establishing meadow functionality to the ecosystem as a whole.

Interview Conclusions- Approved

No changes to the Upper Feather River Watershed IRWM Region boundaries are suggested by DWR. DWR recommends the Upper Feather River Watershed RWMG continue coordination efforts with neighboring IRWM Regions they share a boundary with or have areas of Region overlap, and with Valley floor water management interests.
