The Upper Feather River Region submits the following comments:

1. The UFR region appreciates the recommendation for funding the latest planning efforts and opportunity to receive our first grant award for IRWMP planning under the Prop 84 program. We wish to remind you that should a tie breaker consideration develop as part of any final ranking we have as a region not received prior funding are should be considered for an additional 5 points.
2. We reviewed DWR comments and appreciate the high score for the DAC activities and the recognition that Plumas County is a key participant in State Water Project area of origin and is entirely a disadvantaged region.
3. DWR comments regarding the failure to include existing studies in the Work Plan and assure you that this was an oversight and we will include a description of the work performed and the linkage to the IRWM work.
4. DWR comments regarding the schedule are well taken and we will amend the dates of all tasks to fit within proposed grant time period.
5. We have reviewed the recommended award and our work plan and are confident that we can accomplish the goals of the grant application for the 85% recommended award through a revised work plan to be developed following the final recommendations.

On behalf of the region participants we wish to thank the DWR team for what appears to be a fair and equitable consideration of the Grant Applications and we appreciate your continued consideration in protecting the draft recommendation of funding at the 85% level.
