The Potter Valley Tribe of Pomo Indians has inhabited the Russian and Eel River watersheds from time of immemorial . As a federally recognized tribe, the Tribe would like to request the following points be incorporated into the North Coast Integrated Water Management Plan's planning fund.

1. Incorporate tribal perspectives into the updated version of the North Coast water plan, possibly using a questionnaire and/or interviews. This should include tribal "needs, knowledge and expectations."
2. Collect and synthesize existing tribal water planning documents, needs assessments, proposals, etc. for inclusion in the updated water plan.
3. Tribes draft portions of the plan and amend others.
