2.1 Is the applicant a local public agency as defined in CWC 10701(a)? Please explain.

The applicant is Merced Irrigation District (MID), a member of MAGPI, submitting this application on behalf of MAGPI. MAGPI is a public entity formed in 1997 under the powers of AB 3030. MAGPI is a joint power association as defined in the water code and has authorized MID to pursue this application as per its Resolution No. 2012-1, which was adopted on June 4, 2012. MAGPI has adopted a Groundwater Management Plan in December 1997 and a Groundwater Management Plan Update in July 2008. MID is a local public agency authorized to receive funding under CWC Sections 1079 et seq.

2.2 What is the statutory or other legal authority under which the applicant was formed and is authorized to operate?

Division 11 – Irrigation Districts – California Water Code

2.3 What is the statutory or other legal authority under which the applicant was formed and is authorized to operate?

MAGPI is a public entity formed in 1997 by a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) under the powers of AB 3030.

2.4 Describe any legal authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State of California?

Yes. MID has legal authority to enter into a grant agreement under the statutory authority contained in CWC Sections 22075, 22078, 22225, and 22230.
