

Attachment 2. Eligible Applicant Documentation

The Borrego Water District is a local public agency and was formed in 1962 as a California water district under Water Codes 35200 - 35206 (election methods) and section 35565 (provisions pertaining only to the Borrego Water District).

The Borrego Water District does have legal authority to enter into an agreement with the State of California.

The Borrego Water District established and adopted a Groundwater Management Plan under AB 3030 (1992) in 2002 and updated the plan in 2006.

The Borrego Water District is the approved CASGEM monitoring entity for the Borrego Valley.

The Borrego Water District is presently working with the County of San Diego in the form of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to act as the monitoring entity of the County's "Water Credit Program" under a proposed amendment to the County Groundwater Ordinance. The county document requires new development to mitigate the groundwater overdraft by retiring present water usage to make room for new development. Documents are presently with County Counsel and are expected to be signed in the next few weeks.
