Groundwater Recharge Mapping and Water Quality Protection Program Western Placer County, California

The attached schedule provides the duration of each task and subtask through completion of the project. The following assumptions were used in developing the schedule so that it is representative of the actual duration of the project. The assumptions and considerations are:

- A start date of April 1, 2013.
- Preparation of the final easement and environmental documentation (Tasks 4.2 and 4.3) will occur first, during 2013. Task 4.1, preparation of Plans and Specifications and bidding and selecting a contractor will occur through the winter months of 2013-14. Drilling, construction of the monitoring wells is planned to begin until May of 2014, when dry conditions should allow easy access to all drill sites.
- The duration of drilling was estimated to be a total of 15 weeks, using conservative round numbers of 5 days per monitoring well and 20 additional days for development and site clean-up.

The City of Roseville and its WPC Partners are ready to proceed with the project as soon as the grant funding becomes available. The schedule includes three months of float between environmental documentation and monitoring well construction. The program will be completed by January 2015, three months prior to the close of the grant period.
