The City has a Chief Financial Officer, Lawrence Chiu, who performs all accounting functions for the City of Santa Rosa and is responsible for the tracking of funds on behalf of the City. The Santa Rosa City Council may hire consultants and direct staff to carry out the requirements of the proposal. The Utilities Department Director, Miles A. Ferris, is a Senior Management Staff member of the City, and the City Council is scheduled to consider a resolution on July 31, 2012 which would delegate the authority to direct staff and consultants to ensure the performance of the proposal.
