

The McKinleyville Community Services District (MCSD) is a local agency as defined in Section 10701 of the California Water Code. Local agency includes a district as a political subdivision of the State for the local performance of governmental or proprietary functions within limited boundaries.

The MCSD was formed after a special election conducted within the area proposed for formation on April 21, 1970. The MCSD was formed as an independent multi-purpose district organized pursuant to Section 61000 of the California Government Code, and is authorized to provide the following services:

- Water Service
- Wastewater Collection and Treatment
- Parks and Recreation Services
- Street Lighting

Yes, the MCSD has legal authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State of California and has done so on several prior occasions.

While there are no legal agreements with other partner agencies, the MCSD staff will ensure that its staff and consultants working on the Groundwater Management Plan and testing project adhere to the established project schedule as enumerated in the application. The MCSD's Finance Director will track and ensure that all project funding requests are appropriately prepared and submitted to the State in a timely manner.
