

Thank you for participating in the California Statewide Groundwater Elevation Monitoring (CASGEM) Program. On 12/27/2010, County of Napa notified the Department of Water Resources (DWR) of its intention to assume responsibility for monitoring and reporting groundwater elevations in all or part of a basin or subbasin. DWR's review and verification of the information submitted to the CASGEM Online Submittal System (OSS) is currently in progress. Once we have completed our review, you will be contacted and notified of your Monitoring Entity status. Based on our review, you may be required to clarify or re-submit information from your initial notification.

We are expecting to re-open the CASGEM OSS in early May 2011 to allow for agencies to enter missing or incorrect information (if required), and to allow for approved or conditionally-approved Monitoring Entities to enter groundwater monitoring plans and monitoring well network information.
