

**Resolution Supporting the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency Application to the California Department of Water Resources for a Local Groundwater Assistance Grant pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality Coastal Protection and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Board Act of 2006 (Public Resource Code (PRC) Water Code Section 75001 *et seq.*)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-3**

**Whereas**, the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency has had the authority given to it by statute approved October 8, 1991 to manage the groundwater resources in the Ojai Basin, and;

**Whereas**, the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency recently completed a MODFLOW of the Ojai Groundwater Basin;

**Whereas**, the most recent Groundwater Management Plan adopted by the agency provides for the measurement of stream flow into, within, and exiting the Basin;

**Whereas**, the agency wishes to evaluate and augment recharge along creek channels for maximum groundwater recharge capability, and;

**Whereas**, the Department of Water Resources, through the Local Groundwater Assistance Grant Program, is requesting grant proposals from local agencies who have completed their Groundwater Management Plan to submit a proposal for grant funding, and;

**Whereas**, the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency has already completed all the requirements for this grant proposal, and;

**Whereas**, the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency proposes to locate, design, furnish, install and monitor five stream gauges on creeks within their jurisdiction. Stream flow data will support the understanding of the Basin, recharge and discharge component of the system, and also support ongoing artificial recharge efforts of the San Antonio Creek Spreading Grounds Rehabilitation Project;

**Therefore be it Resolved** by the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency that application be made to the California Department of Water Resources for a Local Groundwater Assistance Grant pursuant to the Water Security, Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002 (Water Code Section 79560 *et seq.*), and to enter into an agreement to receive a grant for the Local Groundwater Assistance Grant. The President of the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency is hereby authorized and directed to prepare the necessary data, conduct investigations and file such application with California Department of Water Resources.
