Is the applicant a local public agency as defined in CWC 10701(a)?

Yes, the San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors Water Authority is a Joint Powers Authority comprised of four other water management entities; Central California Irrigation District, Columbia Canal Company, Firebaugh Canal Water District, and San Luis Canal Company.

What is the statutory or other legal authority under which the applicant was formed and is authorized to operate?

The SJRECWA was formed pursuant to Title 1, Division 7, Chapter 5, Article 1 (Section 6500) of the California Government Code, the Joint Exercise of Powers.

Does the applicant have legal Authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State of California?

Yes, pursuant to Government Code Section 6500 et seq and Water Code 20500 et seq.
