The goal of the proposed project is the proper destruction of three former municipal drinking water supply wells to protect and maintain the District's drinking water aquifer. The wells identified for destruction (Al Tahoe #1, Country Club Well, and Industrial Well No. 2) have all been selected due to their exposure to contaminants and to prevent these contaminants from entering a deep semi-confined water bearing zone used by STPUD as the main drinking water supply for the South Lake Tahoe area. This proposal relates to the STPUD GWMP by helping to achieve the goal "to maintain Groundwater supplies and protect Groundwater quality. The purpose of this Plan is to regulate, manage, conserve and protect the Groundwater resources available to the District so that the Groundwater will remain a viable potable water resource and be available to be put to the most efficient and beneficial use by the District and its customers.
