Project Description	The primary goal of the proposed project, STPUD Groundwater Management Plan Revision/Update, is to revise/update the current groundwater management plan to bring it into compliance with all pertinent codes and regulations. The South Tahoe Public Utility District adopted the current Groundwater Management Plan (GWMP) in 2000.
