DWR Plans Daily Media Briefings This Week at State-Federal Flood Center

SACRAMENTO--To assist the news media in covering current storms and their impacts, officials of the State Department of Water Resources will hold daily news briefings this week at the State-Federal Flood Operations Center, starting at 10:30 am each day, through Friday.

The flood center is located at 3310 El Camino Avenue, approximately 10 miles northeast of downtown Sacramento and one long block west of Watt Avenue.

Briefings will be conducted in the second flood media room.
