Flooding Cancels Willows Public Workshop

WILLOWS (Glenn County)--A workshop scheduled for Feb. 5 in Willows Memorial Hall has been canceled due to local flooding from Willow Creek.

Instead of a workshop to discuss off-stream water storage alternatives, the hall will be used as a flood shelter.

This announcement was made today by officials of the Department of Water Resources. The workshop, to be presented in cooperation with Glenn County, will be rescheduled at the earliest possible date.
