DWR's Water Bonds 2000 Web Site Is Now Online

SACRAMENTO---The Department of Water Resources has posted for public access a Water Bond 2000 Web site.

The Web Site provides basic information on the \$1.97 billion Water Bond approved by California's voters at the March 7 primary election and on DWR implementation of Water Bond programs.

The Water Bond 2000 Web site went online May 10, coinciding with the start of the Spring Conference of the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) in Monterey. ACWA represents more than 430 public water agencies in California.

The Web site includes key points from a [May 10 Water Bond Update](#) presentation at the ACWA Conference by Lucinda Chipponeri, DWR's Assistant Director for Legislation and the coordinator of DWR's Water Bond implementation effort.

ACWA members and agencies are encouraged to access and link to DWR's Water Bond 2000 Web site.

DWR's Water Bond 2000 Web site will grow as more details become available, especially on funding in new programs.
