PROPOSITION 13 WORKSHOPS

SACRAMENTO - The California Department of Water Resources plans workshops this week in Chico and Ontario to help public agencies learn how to submit proposals under the Safe Drinking Water, Clean Water, Watershed Protection and Flood Protection Act (Proposition 13, Statutes of 2000, Chapter 725).

Programs to be covered include Groundwater Recharge construction loans and Groundwater Storage feasibility study, pilot project and construction grants, Agricultural and Urban Water Conservation feasibility study grants and construction loans, Infrastructure Rehabilitation feasibility study and construction grants.

Approved by the voters in March 2000, Proposition 13 provides funding for studies and projects that promote effective management of the State's water resources, enhance local water supply reliability, and increase the beneficial use of existing supplies, including water conservation projects that increase water use efficiency and groundwater recharge and storage projects that facilitate conjunctive management of surface water and groundwater.
