**DWR ANNOUNCES GROUNDWATER GRANT APPLICATIONS  
AND SCHEDULES WORKSHOPS**

SACRAMENTO - The Department of Water Resources announces that final applications for grants and loans for the Groundwater Recharge and Groundwater Storage Construction Programs are now available for review.

For fiscal year 2002-03, grants totaling \$76,840,000 are available for the Groundwater Storage Construction program and loans totaling \$8,720,000 are available for the Groundwater Recharge Construction program.
