DWR To Hold Public Workshop in City of
Colusa on Emergency Levee Repairs

Sacramento -- The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) will hold the final of six public workshop meetings on emergency levee repairs in the Sacramento River Flood Control System. This meeting will focus on levee repairs in the Colusa region.

When: July 6, 2006 – 6 p.m.

Where: City of Colusa, City Council Chambers, 425 Webster Street, Colusa, CA 95932

The public workshops are part of an Executive Order signed by Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger earlier this year directing the Department to repair a total of 29 critical erosion sites along the Sacramento River Flood Control System.
