DWR To Hold Public Meeting in Chico
on Emergency Levee Repairs

SACRAMENTO – The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) is conducting a public meeting in Chico Wednesday evening to outline emergency repairs scheduled for levee sites in the region.

DWR, in close coordination with the Corps and with the support of the Sacramento River Conservation Area Forum (SRCAF) is conducting this meeting to provide up-to-date information and solicit community feedback pertaining to the levee repair sites listed below:

- Sacramento River sites [182.0 R](#) and [99.5 R](#)
- Butte Creek site [0.8 L](#)
- Bear River site [1.2 L](#)

DWR, Corps, and SRCAF staff will be on hand to answer any questions, provide detailed information, and disseminate educational materials.

The meeting will begin a 6 p.m. Wednesday, April 11, 2007 at the City of Chico Chamber of Commerce, 300 Salem Street, Chico.
