**DWR Co-Hosts Climate Change: Water Adaptation Summit**

Sacramento -- The Department of Water Resources (DWR) and the Water Education Foundation are sponsoring a one-day event -- Climate Change: Water Adaptation Summit.

The October 3 summit at the Doubletree Hotel in Santa Monica will address a host of issues related to adapting to future conditions such as water supply and quality, flood management and ecosystem sustainability in California.

The agenda includes a discussion of findings from the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change 4th Assessment, moderated by Jeanine Jones, DWR. Other topics will include integrated regional water management opportunities, challenges in the Bay-Delta, agricultural perspective on water management and more.

DWR Director Lester A. Snow will present awards for Climate Science Services during lunch. A reception sponsored by CH2M Hill and The Ferguson Group will follow closing remarks.
